SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators until October 1, 2026.

AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators until October 1, 2026.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators until October 1,

30 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Board
31 of Examiners of Assisted Living Administrators, created and
32 functioning pursuant to Chapter 2A of Title 34, Code of
33 Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code sections are
34 expressly preserved.

35 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
36 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
37 Sections 1 and 2.

38 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
