SYNOPSIS:

Existing law does not authorize the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board to own real property.

This bill would authorize the board to own its warehouses used for holding and distributing alcoholic beverages.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board; to authorize the board to own its warehouses and the real property on which the warehouses are located.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 28-3-43.1 is added to the Code of Alabama to read as follows:

§28-3-43.1

Notwithstanding any other provision of this title, the board may acquire and hold, in its own name, real property by purchase, gift, or other lawful means, except eminent domain, solely for the purpose of owning and operating a warehouse or warehouses.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
