1 Enrolled, An Act,

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4 To adopt and incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975,
5 those general and permanent laws of the state enacted during
6 the 2023 First Special Session, the 2023 Regular Session, and
7 the 2023 Second Special Session as contained in the 2023
8 Cumulative Supplements to certain volumes of the code and 2024
9 Replacement Volumes 16, 21, and 21A; and to adopt and
10 incorporate into the Code of Alabama 1975, the 2023 Cumulative
11 Supplements to local law volumes; to make corrections in
12 certain volumes of the cumulative supplements and replacement
13 volumes; to specify that this adoption and incorporation
14 constitute a continuous systematic codification of the entire
15 Code of Alabama 1975, and that this act is a law that adopts a
16 code; to declare that the Code Publisher has certified that it
17 has discharged its duties regarding the replacement volumes;
18 to expressly provide that this act does not affect any 2024
19 session statutes; and to specify the duties of the Secretary
20 of State regarding the custody of the cumulative supplements
21 and replacement volumes.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

23 Section 1.(a) Those general and permanent laws of the
24 state enacted during the 2023 First Special Session, the 2023
25 Regular Session, and the 2023 Second Special Session as
26 contained in the 2023 Cumulative Supplements to Volumes 3 to
27 15B, inclusive, Volumes 16A to 20, inclusive, and Volumes 22
28 to 22A, inclusive, and the 2023 Replacement Volumes 16, 21,



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29 and 21A, and the additions and deletions made by the Code
30 Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and published
31 by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which volumes of
32 the 2023 Cumulative Supplements and 2023 Replacement Volumes
33 16, 21, and 21A are identified and authenticated by the Great
34 Seal of the State of Alabama placed upon the front and back of
35 each of the volumes of the cumulative supplements and upon the
36 first inside page and the last inside page of the replacement
37 volumes, are adopted and incorporated into the Code of Alabama
38 1975.

39 (b) The following corrections are made:

40 (1) Section 20-2A-62, 2023 Cumulative Supplement to
41 Volume 14, page 207. To correct a publishing error in
42 subdivision (d)(4), replace "Cultivatars" with "Cultivars."

43 (2) Section 22-24-12, 2015 Replacement Volume 14A, page
44 802. To delete Section 22-24-12 in its entirety, as this
45 section was repealed by implication in Sections 3 and 4 of Act
46 2023-444.

47 (3) Section 27-17A-2, 2024 Replacement Volume 16, pages
48 463 to 468, inclusive. To delete Section 27-17A-2 in its
49 entirety, as this section was retained in the Code of Alabama
50 1975, due to a scrivener's error in Act 2023-94.

51 (4) Section 26-10E-19, 2023 Cumulative Supplement to
52 Volume 15B, page 56. To correct a scrivener's error and
53 conform the language in subdivision (a)(2) to the federal act
54 referenced in the subdivision, replace "for five years or
55 more." with "in the preceding five years."

56 (5) Section 45-22-100.07, 2023 Cumulative Supplement to



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57 Volume 22E, page 55. To redesignate Section 45-22-100.07 as
58 Section 45-22A-40.

59 Section 2. Those local and permanent laws of the state
60 previously enacted and contained in the local and permanent
61 laws pertaining to various counties enacted during the 2023
62 First Special Session, the 2023 Regular Session, and the 2023
63 Second Special Session, as contained in the 2023 Cumulative
64 Supplements to Volumes 22B, 22C, 22D, 22E, 22F, 22G, 22H, 22I,
65 22J, 22K, 22L, and 22M and the additions and deletions made by
66 the Code Commissioner for editorial purposes, as edited and
67 published by Thomson Reuters, as the Code Publisher, which
68 volumes of the 2023 Cumulative Supplements are identified and
69 authenticated by the Great Seal of the State of Alabama placed
70 upon the front and back of each of the volumes of the
71 cumulative supplements, are adopted and incorporated into the
72 Code of Alabama 1975.

73 Section 3. The adoption and incorporation of the
74 supplements and replacement volumes specified in this act
75 shall constitute a continuous systematic codification of the
76 entire Code of Alabama 1975, for purposes of Section 85 of the
77 Constitution of Alabama of 2022. This act is a law that adopts
78 a code for the purposes of Section 45 of the Constitution of
79 Alabama of 2022. Notwithstanding the foregoing, nothing in
80 this act shall be deemed to codify any provision of law that
81 was adopted in violation of any provision of the Constitution
82 of Alabama of 2022, establishing requirements for, or
83 limitations on, the enactment of a law.

84 Section 4. It is declared that Thomson Reuters, as the



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85 Code Publisher, has certified that it has discharged its
86 duties and responsibilities to edit and publish 2024
87 Replacement Volumes 16, 21, and 21A of the Code of Alabama
88 1975, by combining the material in the previous bound volumes
89 with the material contained in the cumulative supplements
90 without making substantive changes, but making, under the
91 supervision and pursuant to the direction of the Code
92 Commissioner, nonsubstantive changes and corrections as may
93 have resulted from changes in reference numbers, changes of
94 names and titles of governmental departments, agencies, and
95 officers, typographical errors, grammatical changes, and
96 misspellings.

97 Section 5. The adoption of this act shall not repeal,
98 supersede, amend, or in any other way affect any statute
99 enacted into law during any 2024 session of the Legislature.

100 Section 6. Upon passage and approval of this act, the
101 duly authenticated volumes of the 2023 Cumulative Supplements
102 and the 2024 Replacement Volumes 16, 21, and 21A shall be
103 transmitted to the Secretary of State, who shall file the
104 volumes of the supplements and the replacement volumes in that
105 office. The volumes of the supplements and replacement volumes
106 shall not be removed from the office of the Secretary of
107 State, but the Secretary of State, upon request, under proper
108 certificate and seal of that office, shall certify any part or
109 parts thereof upon payment of the fee specified by law for
110 similar services.

111 Section 7. This act shall become effective immediately.
