SYNOPSIS:

This bill would propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to remove any real property owned by the University of Mobile in the corporate limits of any municipality from the corporate limits of the municipality.

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, to remove any real property owned by the University of Mobile in the corporate limits of any municipality from the corporate limits of the municipality.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The Legislature finds in proposing this amendment, that the University of Mobile is a statewide university, serving students throughout the state and from other states. The Legislature further finds that the University of Mobile is in need of expanding its access to water and sewer services, which can best be accomplished by deannexing from the municipality of which it is currently a part of.

30           Section 2. The following amendment to the Constitution  
31 of Alabama of 2022, is proposed:

### PROPOSED AMENDMENT

33           On the effective date of the ratification of this  
34 amendment, all real property of the University of Mobile, a  
35 nonprofit university in this state, in the corporate limits of  
36 any municipality, is removed and deannexed from the corporate  
37 limits of the municipality.

38           Upon ratification of this constitutional amendment, the  
39 Code Commissioner shall number and place this amendment as  
40 appropriate in the constitution omitting this instructional  
41 paragraph and may make the following nonsubstantive revisions:  
42 change capitalization, hierarchy, spelling, and punctuation  
43 for purposes of style and uniformity; correct manifest  
44 grammatical, clerical, and typographical errors; revise  
45 internal or external citations and cross-references; harmonize  
46 language; and translate effective dates.

### END PROPOSED AMENDMENT

48           Section 3. An election upon the proposed amendment  
49 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284, 284.01, and 285  
50 of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, and the election laws  
51 of this state. The appropriate election official shall assign  
52 a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on  
53 the election ballot and shall set forth the following  
54 description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed  
55 constitutional amendment:

66 Section 4. The proposed amendment shall become valid as  
67 part of the Constitution of Alabama of 2022, when approved by  
68 a majority of the qualified electors voting thereon.
