SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, the Director of the Alabama State Personnel Department is charged with providing the requirements for employment within classes of positions in the state service.

This bill would require the State Personnel Director to regularly assess the requirements for employment within classifications of positions in the state service and identify classifications for which the requirements may be reduced.

This bill would also require the State Personnel Director to reduce the number of classifications of positions in the state service for which a four-year college degree is required for employment, to the extent practicable.

Relating to state employment; to require the State Personnel Director to regularly assess the requirements for employment in positions in the state service; to require the director to identify positions for which the requirements for

33 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

34 Section 1. The State Director of Personnel shall:

35 (1) Regularly assess the educational, experiential, and
36 training requirements necessary for each classification of
37 positions in the state service.

38 (2) Identify classifications of positions in the state
39 service for which the educational, experiential, or training
40 requirements could be reduced from their present level.

41 (3) Reduce, to the extent practicable, the number of
42 classifications of positions in the state service for which a
43 four-year college degree is required for employment.

44 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
45 1, 2024.
