5	AWARENESS MONTH IN THE STATE OF ALABAMA.
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7	WHEREAS, Fanconi Anemia (FA) is a rare, inherited DNA
8	repair disorder that affects bone marrow and many other
9	parts of the body; people with FA have an increased risk of
10	bone marrow failure, physical abnormalities, organ defects,
11	and certain cancers; and
12	WHEREAS, research has shown that FA is a
13	cancer-susceptibility disease caused by faulty DNA repair,
14	and individuals with the disease have an extremely high risk
15	of developing cancer at a young age; individuals with FA are
16	hundreds of times more likely to develop cancers such as
17	leukemia; head, neck, and oral cancers; gynecological
18	cancers; and gastrointestinal cancers at a much earlier age
19	than the general population; and
20	WHEREAS, Fanconi Anemia is very rare; it occurs in
21	one in 160,000 individuals worldwide; most of the time, FA
22	is diagnosed during childhood or young adulthood; it affects
23	both males and females equally and is found in all ethnic
24	groups; and
25	WHEREAS, there are currently 23 genes known to cause
26	Fanconi Anemia, including the BRCA1 and BRCA2, which are
27	better known as breast cancer susceptibility genes; the

disease is primarily inherited in a recessive fashion,

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29	requiring an individual to inherit two defective copies of
30	the same FA gene; and
31	WHEREAS, individuals with Fanconi Anemia require
32	specialized protocols and heavily rely on research and
33	clinical trials; research has resulted in better outcomes
3 4	and longer lives for those with FA, and there is now a
35	growing population of adults living with the disease; and
36	WHEREAS, further Fanconi Anemia research will benefit
37	both individuals with FA and the general public through
38	better understanding the mechanisms of DNA repair and cance:
39	development; it can lead to improved cancer preventatives,
40	cancer treatments, and ultimately a cure for FA; now
