SJR___ NAMING THE BRIDGE ON ALABAMA STATE HIGHWAY ROUTE 158 THAT SPANS MCCRARY ROAD IN MOBILE COUNTY, ALABAMA, THE WILLIAM "BILL" STUCKEY MEMORIAL BRIDGE.
