| 12 | Rocky Mountain Spotted Fever, become prevalent in the spring |

| 14 | WHEREAS, because the symptoms of Lyme disease and |
| 15 | other tick-borne illnesses are similar to flu and cold |
| 16 | symptoms, these illnesses are often misdiagnosed; and |
| 17 | WHEREAS, tick-born diseases and illnesses have been |
| 18 | on the rise nationally; in Alabama, the number of cases of |
| 19 | Lyme disease almost doubled from 36 in 2018 to 66 in 2019; |
| 20 | and the number of cases of spotted fever rickettsiosis, the |
| 21 | most common tick-borne illness in Alabama, increased from 14 |
| 22 | in 2000 to 673 in 2018; and |
| 23 | WHEREAS, researchers have also identified emerging |
| 24 | threats from ticks, including a couple of illnesses in |
| 25 | humans caused by tick-borne pathogens they previously |
| 26 | believed only infected animals; the new Heartland virus, |
| 27 | identified in 2009, is carried by lone star ticks; now |
