(b) Notwithstanding any provision to the contrary, this act shall have no effect on any condemnation action or proceeding to acquire for public use all or any portion or interest in the receivership property, whether filed before or after the receivership. The receivership court may not stay or enjoin any condemnation action involving the receivership property, nor shall the receivership court have jurisdiction over any action to condemn the receivership property. The receiver may negotiate to



25            settle any condemnation action involving the  
26            receivership property and may convey to the condemning  
27            authority the property or interest therein sought to  
28            be condemned. The receiver may be named as a defendant  
29            in any eminent domain or condemnation action involving  
30            the receivership property.
