(e) Licensure requirements shall not apply to an individual pursuing a course of study leading to a doctor of chiropractic degree, or postgraduate training which is approved by the board, if the individual: (i) is designated by a title indicating student status; (ii) is fulfilling clinical training requirements for the attainment of a degree; and (iii) is under the supervision of a chiropractor licensed pursuant to this article.

(f) Nothing in this article shall be construed as preventing the practice of chiropractic services or activities provided by of either the following:

(1) Any individual licensed to practice chiropractic in this or another state who is employed as a professor or instructor by a chiropractic school or college located in this state.

(2) Any individual enrolled in or teaching a course of study designed to develop chiropractic clinical skills when chiropractic activities are required as part of an educational program sponsored by a chiropractic school or college, or other educational program approved by the board."
