## SYNOPSIS:

This bill makes supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025: from Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy Fund to the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy in the amount of \$100,000; from Court Automation Fund to the Unified Judicial System in the amount of \$8,017,325; from Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund to the Unified Judicial System in the amount of \$4,588,740; and amends Act 2024-355, the General Fund Appropriation Bill for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, to increase the amount appropriated to the Alabama Department of Transportation for paying the principal of and interest on bonds issued for the purposes of public highways and bridges.

To make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025: from Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy Fund to the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy in the amount of \$100,000; from Court Automation

- 37 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
- 38 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations
- 39 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
- 40 \$100,000 from Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy Fund
- 41 to the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy for the
- 42 fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.
- Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations
- 44 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
- \$8,017,325 from Court Automation Fund to the Unified Judicial
- 46 System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.
- 47 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds
- 48 appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and
- 49 personnel costs and for other general operations of the
- 50 Unified Judicial System.
- 51 Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations
- 52 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated
- \$4,588,740 from Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund to
- 54 the Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending
- 55 September 30, 2025. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary,
- the funds appropriated under this section may be spent on



- 57 salaries and personnel costs and for other general operations 58 of the Unified Judicial System.
- Section 4. Section 3C of Act 2024-355, the General
- Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 30,
- 61 2025, is hereby amended as follows:
- "124. Transportation Department of...
- There is hereby appropriated for payment of the
- 64 principal of and the interest on all bonds heretofore or
- 65 hereafter issued for public highways and bridge purposes, or
- 66 either, by the State of Alabama, Alabama Federal Aid Highway
- 67 Finance Authority, Alabama Highway Finance Corporation, or
- 68 Alabama Industrial Access Road and Bridge Corporation, a total
- of \$113,253,921 \$126,253,921 or so much thereof as may be
- 70 necessary for payment of said principal and interest at their
- 71 respective maturities, of the revenues pledged for such
- 72 payment. There is also hereby appropriated an amount not to
- exceed \$25,000,000 as an annual contribution to the Alabama
- 74 Transportation Infrastructure Bank, if needed, for payment of
- debt service. The Director of Transportation, with the consent
- of the Governor and the Director of Finance, shall have the
- authority to transfer any appropriation or any portion thereof
- 78 between and among subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) of this
- 79 section whenever such transfer shall be necessary to assure
- 80 maximum utilization of federal matching funds which shall
- 81 become available. In the event that there shall not be
- 82 sufficient funds available for payment of all appropriations
- 83 hereinabove made, the following provisions shall be
- 84 applicable. In the event of such insufficiency in respect of



85 said revenues accruing to the Department of Transportation: 86 (1) the appropriation made for Debt Service in subdivisions 87 (a) and (b) hereof shall be paid in full, and (2) the 88 appropriations from the revenues accruing to the Department of 89 Transportation that are herein made for the purposes referred 90 to in subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) except for Debt Service, 91 hereof shall be allocated among the purposes referred to in 92 said subdivisions in such order and with such priorities as 93 the Director of the Department of Transportation shall from time to time direct. The funds appropriated in subdivisions 94 95 (a) and (c) hereof, for the matching federal funds, shall not revert at the end of the fiscal year for which such 96 97 appropriations are made but shall remain available for the 98 purposes for which such appropriations were made. In addition 99 to all appropriations hereinabove made, there is hereby appropriated to the Department of Transportation all federal 100 funds accruing thereto to be expended only for the purpose for 101 102 which such Funds are made available." 103 Section 5. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its 104 105 otherwise becoming law.
