(a) For the purposes of this section, the 14 term "machine gun" means any weapon which shoots, is 15 16 designed to shoot, or can be readily restored to shoot, automatically more than one shot, without manual reloading, 17 18 by a single function of the trigger. The term shall include the frame or receiver of any such weapon, any part designed 19 and intended solely and exclusively, or combination of parts 20 21 designed and intended, for use in converting a weapon into a 22 machine gun, and any combination of parts from which a 23 machine gun can be assembled if such parts are in the possession or under the control of a person. 24 25 (b) A person who possesses, obtains, receives, sells, or uses a part or combination of parts designed and intended 26

30 (1) A state or local law enforcement officer while31 acting in an official capacity.

Although this bill would have as its purpose A4 or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of A5 local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements A6 and application under Section 111.05 of the Constitution of A1abama of 2022, because the bill defines a new crime or A8 amends the definition of an existing crime.
