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19	Relating to the Alabama Board of Examiners for
20	Speech-Language Pathology and Audiology; to add Section
21	34-28A-21.1 to the Code of Alabama 1975, to provide further
22	for the minimum qualifications for registration as a
23	speech-language pathology assistant.
24	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
25	Section 1. Section 34-28A-21.1 is added to the Code of
26	Alabama 1975, to read as follows:
27	§34-28A-21.1
28	(a) Any person not eligible for a license under this

- 30 pathology assistant. Eligible candidates for registration as a
- 31 speech-language pathology assistant shall do all of the
- 32 following:
- 33 (1) Practice only under the supervision of a licensed
- 34 speech-language pathologist.
- 35 (2) Have completed the minimum of 30 semester credit
- 36 hours at a community college or university in speech and
- 37 hearing sciences or communication disorders, of which three
- 38 hours shall be dedicated to studying language disorders, and
- 39 three hours shall be focused on speech disorders.
- 40 Additionally, a speech-language pathology assistant in an
- 41 associate degree program shall successfully complete not less
- than 100 clinical practicum hours under the supervision of a
- 43 credentialed speech-language pathologist under any clinical
- 44 practicum setting. A speech-language pathology assistant who
- does not hold a bachelor's degree or equivalent in speech and
- 46 hearing sciences or communication disorders shall provide
- 47 services in an educational, private practice, nonresidential
- 48 health care, early intervention, and other nonhospital
- 49 settings.
- 50 (b) For the purposes of this section, "community
- 51 college" refers to Wallace State Community College-Hanceville,
- 52 under the purview of the Alabama Community College System, and
- "university" refers to any four-year public institution of
- 54 higher education located in this state.
- 55 (c)(1) A speech-language pathology assistant shall have
- a scope of practice as defined by the American



- 57 Speech-Language-Hearing Association.
- 58 (2) The supervising speech-language pathologist shall
- have held a full, unrestricted speech-language pathologist
- 60 license for at least two years before supervising the
- speech-language pathology assistant and possess the necessary
- 62 credentials required by the board. A supervising
- 63 speech-language pathologist may not supervise more than three
- full-time equivalent speech-language pathology assistants in
- 65 any one setting.
- (d) Registration as a speech-language pathology
- assistant may be renewed annually, pursuant to this chapter,
- 68 without limitation as to number of times renewed.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on January
- 70 1, 2026.
