Replace line 562 on page 23 with the following:

Section 5. (a) Effective October 1, 2027, the Joint Legislative Study Commission on Law Enforcement Officer Recruitment Retention shall be established. The commission shall be composed of the following members:

- (1) The Chair of the House Judiciary Committee.
- (2) The Chair of the Senate Judiciary Committee.
- (3) The Chair of the Senate Veterans, Military Affairs, and Public Safety Committee.

(4) The Chair of the House Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee.

- (5) The House Minority Leader.
- (6) The Senate Minority Leader.

(b) The members of the study commission shall convene its initial meeting not later than November 1, 2027, at



25 which meeting the members shall elect a chair and vice
26 chair. The study commission may meet as necessary to
27 perform its duties.

28 (c) The study commission shall study the effects of
29 this act to determine its effect on the recruitment and
30 retention of law enforcement officers at the state,
31 county, and municipal level, as well as the recruitment
32 and retention of correctional officers through the
33 Department of Corrections.

34 (d) The study commission, not later than the 10th
35 legislative day of the 2028 Regular Session, shall
36 provide its recommendations to the Legislature for
37 further revisions to this act and the Code of Alabama
38 1975, as needed to support the recruitment and retention
39 of law enforcement officers and correctional officers in
40 a cost effective manner that benefits the residents of
41 the State of Alabama. After the submission of the
42 proposed legislation, the study commission shall stand
43 dissolved.

44 (e) The members of the study commission shall be
45 entitled to their legislative compensation, per diem, and
46 travel expenses for each day they attend a meeting of the
47 study commission pursuant to Section 49 of the
48 Constitution of Alabama of 2022.
