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- 7 SYNOPSIS:

8 This bill makes supplemental appropriations for 9 the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025: from Alabama 10 State Board of Public Accountancy Fund to the Alabama 11 State Board of Public Accountancy in the amount of \$100,000; from Court Automation Fund to the Unified 12 Judicial System in the amount of \$8,017,325; from 13 14 Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund to the 15 Unified Judicial System in the amount of \$4,588,740; 16 from the Alabama Recycling Fund to the Department of Environmental Management in the amount of \$2,000,000; 17 18 from Departmental Receipts to the Department of Commerce in the amount of \$5,000,000; from federal 19 20 funds from the American Rescue Plan Act - State Small 21 Business Initiative Fund to the Department of Finance 22 in the amount of \$50,000,000, estimated; and amends Act 23 2024-355, the General Fund Appropriation Bill for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, to increase the 24 25 amount appropriated to the Alabama Department of 26 Transportation for paying the principal of and interest 27 on bonds issued for the purposes of public highways and 28 bridges.

55 Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations 56 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated



57 \$100,000 from Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy Fund 58 to the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy for the 59 fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.

60 Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated 61 \$8,017,325 from the Court Automation Fund to the Unified 62 63 Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. 64 Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and 65 personnel costs and for other general operations of the 66 67 Unified Judicial System.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations 68 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated 69 70 \$4,588,740 from the Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund 71 to the Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, 72 73 the funds appropriated under this section may be spent on 74 salaries and personnel costs and for other general operations 75 of the Unified Judicial System.

Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$2,000,000 from the Alabama Recycling Fund to the Department of Environmental Management for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.

81 Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations 82 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated 83 \$5,000,000 from the Departmental Receipts to the Department of 84 Commerce for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.



85 Section 6. (a) In addition to all other appropriations 86 heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$50,000,000, estimated, in federal funds from the American 87 Rescue Plan Act - State Small Business Credit Initiative Fund 88 for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. These funds may 89 90 be delegated through memoranda of agreement to the Alabama 91 Innovation Corporation or other entity so designated by the 92 Department of Finance.

93 Section 7. Any amount of the funds appropriated in 94 this act remaining unexpended on September 30, 2025, shall be 95 reappropriated for the same purposes for the fiscal year 96 beginning October 1, 2025.

97 Section 8. Section 3C of Act 2024-355, the General
98 Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 30,
99 2025, is hereby amended as follows:

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"124. Transportation Department of...

101 There is hereby appropriated for payment of the 102 principal of and the interest on all bonds heretofore or 103 hereafter issued for public highways and bridge purposes, or 104 either, by the State of Alabama, Alabama Federal Aid Highway 105 Finance Authority, Alabama Highway Finance Corporation, or 106 Alabama Industrial Access Road and Bridge Corporation, a total 107 of \$113,253,921 \$126,253,921 or so much thereof as may be 108 necessary for payment of said principal and interest at their 109 respective maturities, of the revenues pledged for such payment. There is also hereby appropriated an amount not to 110 exceed \$25,000,000 as an annual contribution to the Alabama 111 112 Transportation Infrastructure Bank, if needed, for payment of



113 debt service. The Director of Transportation, with the consent of the Governor and the Director of Finance, shall have the 114 115 authority to transfer any appropriation or any portion thereof 116 between and among subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) of this 117 section whenever such transfer shall be necessary to assure 118 maximum utilization of federal matching funds which shall 119 become available. In the event that there shall not be 120 sufficient funds available for payment of all appropriations 121 hereinabove made, the following provisions shall be applicable. In the event of such insufficiency in respect of 122 123 said revenues accruing to the Department of Transportation: (1) the appropriation made for Debt Service in subdivisions 124 (a) and (b) hereof shall be paid in full, and (2) the 125 126 appropriations from the revenues accruing to the Department of 127 Transportation that are herein made for the purposes referred 128 to in subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) except for Debt Service, 129 hereof shall be allocated among the purposes referred to in 130 said subdivisions in such order and with such priorities as 131 the Director of the Department of Transportation shall from 132 time to time direct. The funds appropriated in subdivisions 133 (a) and (c) hereof, for the matching federal funds, shall not revert at the end of the fiscal year for which such 134 135 appropriations are made but shall remain available for the 136 purposes for which such appropriations were made. In addition 137 to all appropriations hereinabove made, there is hereby 138 appropriated to the Department of Transportation all federal funds accruing thereto to be expended only for the purpose for 139 140 which such Funds are made available."



Section 9. This act shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
