10	45-51-84, Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the
11	compensation of the judge of probate.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Section 45-51-84, Code of Alabama 1975, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	"§45-51-84
16	(a) The per annum compensation shall be eighty-eight
17	thousand dollars (\$88,000) for the judge of probate effective
18	October 1, 1996.
19	(b) The compensation amount in subsection (a) shall be
20	paid out of the general fund of the Montgomery County
21	Commission in the same manner as other county employees are
22	paid.
23	(c) Subsequent to October 1, 1996, the compensation
24	amount in subsection (a) shall be increased by the same
25	percentage as the across-the-board percentage increase
26	received by full-time county employees at the same time as the
27	increase is received by the county employees, except that the
28	amount shall not be increased by more than three thousand



29	dollars (\$3,000) in any fiscal year.
30	(d) Beginning October 1, 2025, the individual serving
31	as judge of probate on June 1, 2025, in lieu of any other
32	salary, shall receive a salary of one hundred fifty-three
33	thousand seven hundred twenty-five dollars (\$153,725) per
34	year. If and when the individual qualifies under subsection
35	(e), this subsection shall be void.
36	(e) Any individual who has served at least six full
37	years as the Montgomery County Judge of Probate shall receive
38	as his or her total compensation a salary in an amount equal
39	to the salary of a circuit judge with the same years of
40	service as the judge of probate."
41	Section 2. This act shall become effective on June 1,
