(c) (1) Nothing in this section shall be interpreted as permitting or authorizing compulsory genital inspections or the use of a surveillance camera or monitoring device in or immediately outside of a single-sex space or environment including, but not limited to, a toilet, bath, or shower facility; locker room; common area within such a facility or room, including an area where a sink or changing table is located; or other space open to the public where an individual has a reasonable expectation of privacy, by a public or private individual or entity.

(2) For the purposes of this subsection, a "monitoring device" is a digital video or audio streaming or recording device that monitors activity in an area or building using a system in which signals are transmitted from a video camera or microphone to the receivers by cables or wirelessly, forming a closed circuit, and a "reasonable expectation of privacy" is an individual's



25 reasonable belief, under the circumstances, that the
26 individual can disrobe or partially disrobe in privacy
27 without being concerned that the individual is being
28 viewed, photographed, or filmed when doing so.
