Senate Bill 241 as passed the Senate would increase the obligations of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to develop and operate the statewide inter-jurisdictional Alabama Criminal Enterprise Database and comply with the annual reporting requirements as provided by this bill, subject to the availability of funding. This increase in obligations could be offset, in part, dependent on the amount of civil penalties imposed by the Secretary of ALEA for violating rules regarding the database, as provided by this bill.
