House Bill 105 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security could increase the obligations of certain local law enforcement agencies by: (1) an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to provide a retiring law enforcement officer their badge as part of their retirement benefits, who would not otherwise receive their badge at retirement; and (2) an estimated \$1,000 to allow the agency to provide a retiring law enforcement officer their agency-issued pistol as part of their retirement benefits, who would not otherwise receive their pistol at retirement. This bill would also increase receipts of certain law enforcement agencies by an undetermined amount depending on the fair market value of the pistol sold to the retiring officer.
