House Bill 460 as passed the House of Representatives would appropriate a total of

\$41,059,071 from the Opioid Treatment and Abatement Fund for fiscal year 2025 to the following entities in the following amounts:

- Department of Corrections: \$900,000;
- Board of Pardons and Paroles: \$120,000;
- Department of Mental Health: \$27,860,000;
- Auburn University: \$1 million;
- University of Alabama at Birmingham: \$1 million;
- USA Health University of South Alabama: \$1 million;
- Department of Public Health: \$500,000;
- Administrative Office of Courts for Mental Health: \$3 million;
- Department of Veterans Affairs: \$1.5 million;
- Department of Human Resources: \$500,000
- Office of Prosecution Services: \$2.6 million;
- Department of Forensic Sciences: \$800,000; and
- Department of Senior Services: \$279,071.

This bill would also provide that these funds would not revert at the end of fiscal year 2025 but would be carried forward for the purposes appropriated.
