Senate Bill 216 as introduced would allow certain firemedics personnel retired under the Employees' Retirement System (ERS) to return to work, without suspension of their retirement allowance, as a firemedic with any employer participating in ERS provided that the compensation does not exceed \$52,000 per year. In addition, the compensation cap established by this bill for these retired firefighters and emergency medical services are repealed December 31, 2030, unless extended by an act of the Legislature.

This bill could increase the obligations of several state and local agencies or entities that employ these retired firefighters or emergency medical services by an undetermined amount dependent upon any additional compensation paid to these retirees under the provisions of this bill.
