House Bill 304 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security would revise the distribution of the existing additional \$50 penalty for driving with a canceled, denied, suspended, or revoked license as provided below, which would reduce potential receipts to the Traffic Safety Trust Fund and the Peace Officers' Standards and Training Fund, respectively, and would corresponding increase receipts by the amounts shown below.

| Fund/Entity | Current Law | This Bill | Change in Receipts |
|---|--------------------|------------------|---------------------------|
| Traffic Safety Trust Fund | 50% | 33.3% | -\$52,693 |
| Peace Officers' Standards and Training Fund | 50% | 33.3% | -\$52,693 |
| Local law enforcement agency that issued the citation | - | 33.3% | \$105,386 |

In addition, this bill would require the payment of all reasonable and customary towing and storage fees, as well as all administrative costs, associated with the impoundment of the vehicle.
