Senate Bill 4 as passed the Senate could increase receipts to certain county or municipal governments by an undetermined amount dependent upon the difference in: (1) the amount of funds reimbursed by nonpublic schools for the salary, benefits, and other costs associated with providing a school resource officer to a nonpublic school; and (2) the amount otherwise reimbursed by the nonpublic school absent the provisions of this bill.

In addition, this bill could increase the administrative obligations of local law enforcement entities by an undetermined amount for the provision of security, traffic control and other similar services provided to nonpublic schools.
