## **House Bill 263**

House Bill 263 as passed the House of Representatives would reallocate monthly distributions from the Alabama 911 Board to ensure that local 911 districts receive at least 80% of the balance of the total receipts, after a 1% deduction for administrative expenses of the board. This bill also provides for the remaining balance of the monthly receipts to be used as follows: 1) reimburse carriers for certain 911 technology upgrades; 2) fund the cost of required training and certification of public safety telecommunicators; 3) fund the cost of advisory services to local districts; 4) fund a grant program for districts demonstrating financial hardship; and 5) equally distribute remaining funds to the local districts.
