House Bill 403 as reported by the Committee on Public Safety and Homeland Security would increase the obligations of the Alabama Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA), by an undetermined amount dependent on the cost to develop and operate the statewide inter-jurisdictional Alabama Criminal Enterprise Database, as provided by this bill, subject to the availability of funding. This increase in obligations could be offset, in part, dependent on the amount of civil penalties imposed by the Secretary of ALEA for violations of rules regarding the database, as provided by this bill.
