## **House Bill 287**

**House Bill 287** as passed the House of Representatives could increase the administrative obligations of a state, county, or municipal law enforcement agency to report the number of sworn law enforcement officers employed by each agency. This bill would also increase the administrative obligations of the Alabama Justice Information Commission to adopt rules to implement the provisions of this bill.

Additionally, this bill would increase receipts to the State General Fund and increase the financial obligations of any state, county, or municipal law enforcement agency, that fails to submit reports required pursuant to the provisions of this bill, from the assessment of a \$1,000 fine, and an additional \$1,000 fine every 30 days until the law enforcement agency is in compliance.

Finally, this bill could reduce funding to any state, county, or municipal agency by an undetermined amount dependent on the amount of any state grant funding that is withheld for failure to submit the reports required by the provisions of this bill.
