Senate Bill 206 as introduced could increase the obligations of the Office of the Attorney General, or offices of district attorneys, by an undetermined amount dependent upon the costs to enforce violations of the Deceptive Trade Practices Act, as it relates to assisting or advising an individual with preparation of a claim for veterans benefits. However, any increased obligations could be offset by any civil penalties collected by the Office of the Attorney General, or offices of district attorneys for violations of the Deceptive Trade Practices Act pursuant to the provisions of this bill.
