Senate Bill 285 as introduced would decrease Certificate of Need (CON) receipts to the State Health Planning and Development Agency (SHPDA) by an undetermined amount dependent on the number of health care providers with proposed new or expanded health care services that provide obstetric care, neonatal intensive care, or mental health care, pursuant to the provisions of this bill, beginning October 1, 2025 that would no longer need CON. According to SHPDA, average annual application fees collected from facilities expanding or offering new institutional health services providing obstetrics care, neonatal intensive care, or mental health care was \$110,000 based on fiscal year 2023 and fiscal year 2024 data.
