House Bill 43 (Act 2025-381) as enacted will reduce obligations of the Department of Corrections by an undetermined amount dependent on the number of individuals confined for a lesser period of time under the provisions of this act than otherwise confined under current law.

This act will correspondingly increase the obligations of the Board of Pardons and Paroles by an undetermined amount dependent on the number of individuals placed on probation and supervised by the board and the length of the probation period determined by the court, as provided by this act.

In addition, the provisions of this act may increase the obligations of the Office of Indigent Services, paid from the Fair Trial Tax Fund, and the Administrative Office of Courts, by an undetermined amount, dependent on the number of indigent defendants that attend an accountability court pursuant to this act.
