**House Bill 165** as passed the House of Representatives could increase the obligations of state agencies required to provide services on the Juneteenth state holiday by a minimal, undetermined amount, dependent upon the compensation of the employees, to provide compensatory leave or paid compensation in lieu of the state holiday to employees that work on the Juneteenth state holiday.
