Senate Bill 123 as introduced could increase receipts to the State General Fund from receipts obtained by law enforcement agencies from the sale of seized property by an undetermined amount dependent upon the number of law enforcement agencies (LEAs) that fail to comply with the reporting requirements of this bill on seizures and forfeitures to the Alabama Justice Information Commission (AJIC) and the amounts obtained by the law enforcement agencies. This would also reduce available funds obtained by the LEAs from the sale of seized property by the same corresponding amount and from other funds available to the noncompliant LEAs to pay all reasonable attorney fees and other costs incurred by the AJIC for seeking court action to force LEA compliance with the provisions of this bill.

Additionally, this bill would increase the administrative obligations of the AJIC to comply with reporting requirements established pursuant to the provisions of this bill.
