## **Senate Bill 83**

Senate Bill 83 as reported by the Committee on Finance and Taxation Education would increase the obligations of the state and local entities constructing new, or renovating existing public restrooms, where the cost to renovate is at least \$500,000, by an estimated minimum of \$15,000 to provide for: (1) the installation of an adult-size changing table; and (2) signage indicating the location of the restrooms with the changing table. Beginning with fiscal year 2031, and every three years thereafter, this bill would provide for an increase in the minimum required cost to renovate an existing public restroom based on the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index for the immediately preceding three-year period.

The increased obligations of the state and local entities installing the adult-size changing tables, could be offset by grant funds made available via legislative appropriation.
