House Bill 202 (Act 2025-423) as enacted could increase the obligations of: (1) all state and local law enforcement agencies by an undetermined amount to comply with the reporting requirements provided in this act regarding use of force complaints; and (2) the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission (APOSTC), by an APOSTC-estimated to \$250,000 for initial development costs and an annual estimated \$40,000 for recurring costs to compile and report certain data to the Legislature annually.

In addition, this act could increase the obligations of the Legislature to reimburse legislative members of the Joint Legislative Study Commission on Law Enforcement Legal Protections, created pursuant this act, for per diem and travel expenses by an estimated \$2,300 per meeting beginning in fiscal year 2027 .
