SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, any person who retires in good standing as a law enforcement officer or investigator employed by the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources, the Alcoholic Beverage Control Board, the State Forestry Commission, the Alabama Criminal Justice Information Center, the Public Service Commission, the campus police at a state institution, the Department of Public Safety, or any other state agency that requires its officers to be certified shall receive his or her badge and pistol as part of his or her retirement benefits.

This bill would provide that any individual who retires in good standing as a law enforcement officer employed by any state, county, or municipal agency that requires its officers to be certified shall receive his or her badge and pistol as part of his or her retirement benefits.

31 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

32 Section 1. Section 36-21-8, Code of Alabama 1975, is  
33 amended to read as follows:

34 "§36-21-8

35 Any ~~person~~ individual who, at the time of retirement,  
36 is in good standing and employed by ~~the Department of~~  
37 ~~Conservation and Natural Resources, the Alcoholic Beverage~~  
38 ~~Control Board, the State Forestry Commission, the Alabama~~  
39 ~~Criminal Justice Information Center, the Public Service~~  
40 ~~Commission, campus police at a state institution, or any other~~  
41 ~~state, county, or municipal~~ agency which requires its officers  
42 to be Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training  
43 Commission certified as a law enforcement officer ~~or~~  
44 ~~investigator, or by the Department of Public Safety as a State~~  
45 ~~Capitol Police Officer~~ as defined by Section 36-21-40 shall  
46 receive, as part of his or her retirement benefits, without  
47 cost, his or her badge and pistol."

48 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October  
49 1, 2025.
