SYNOPSIS:

Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendation for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the State Board of Medical Examiners and the Medical Licensure Commission until October 1, 2027, with the following changes: To subject the members of the board and the employees of the board to the state ethics laws.

31 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

32 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the
33 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the State Board
34 of Medical Examiners and the Medical Licensure Commission
35 until October 1, 2027, with additional recommendation for
36 statutory change as set out in Section 3.

37 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the State
38 Board of Medical Examiners and the Medical Licensure
39 Commission, created and functioning pursuant to Sections
40 34-24-50 to 34-24-75.2, inclusive, and 34-24-290 to 34-24-707,
41 inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1,
42 2027, and those code sections are expressly preserved.

43 Section 3. Section 34-24-53.2 is added to the Code of
44 Alabama 1975, to read as follows:

45 Commencing June 1, 2025, each member and employee of
46 the State Board of Medical Examiners is subject to the state
47 ethics laws, Chapter 25 of Title 36, Code of Alabama 1975, or
48 any successor act thereof providing an ethics code for public
49 servants.

50 Section 4. The Legislature concurs in the
51 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
52 Sections 1, 2, and 3.

53 Section 5. This act shall become effective on June 1,
54 2025.
