5	Under existing law, termination dates are
6	established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies
7	are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset
8	Committee. After the review process is completed, the
9	committee prepares its recommendation for the agencies
10	to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which
11	either continue, terminate, or continue with
12	modification each agency reviewed.
13	This bill would provide for the continuance of
14	the Alabama Licensure Board for Interpreters and
15	Transliterators until October 1, 2027.

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Alabama Licensure Board for Interpreters and Transliterators until October 1, 2027.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

> Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Alabama Licensure Board for Interpreters and Transliterators until





- 29 October 1, 2027.
- 30 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the Alabama
- 31 Licensure Board for Interpreters and Transliterators, created
- 32 and functioning pursuant to Sections 34-16-1 to 34-16-16,
- inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued until October 1,
- 34 2027, and those code sections are expressly preserved.
- 35 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the
- 36 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in
- 37 Sections 1 and 2.
- 38 Section 4. This act shall become effective June 1,
- 39 2025.
