9	Relating to criminal procedure; to amend Section
10	15-9-41, Code of Alabama 1975; to further provide for the
11	arrest of an individual for an out-of-state warrant.
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
13	Section 1. Section 15-9-41, Code of Alabama 1975, is
14	amended to read as follows:
15	"\$15-9-41
16	The arrest of a person <u>an individual</u> may be lawfully
17	made also by an officer or a private citizen without a warrant
18	upon reasonable information that the accused stands charged <u>in</u>
19	the courts of another state with a crime punishable by death
20	or life imprisonment in the courts of another state for a term
21	exceeding one year. When so arrested, the accused must be
22	taken before a district or circuit court judge with all
23	practicable speed, and <u>the complaint</u> must be made against him
24	or her under oath setting forth the ground for the arrest as
25	in Section 15-9-40 $_{ au \cdot}$ and thereafter Thereafter, his or her
26	answer shall be heard as if he <u>or she had been arrested on a</u>
27	warrant."
28	Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately.
