4	SYNOPSIS:
5	Under existing law, commonly known as the
6	Omnibus Pay Act, designated elected local officials are
7	entitled to receive the same uniform increases in
8	compensation, such as cost-of-living increases, as
9	county employees. However, the law provides that the
10	uniform increases are not included in the base
11	compensation for the local official.
12	This bill would provide that the uniform
13	increases in compensation granted to local officials
14	would be included in the initial compensation of the
15	local officials.

22	Relating to local county officials; to amend Section
23	11-2A-4 of the Code of Alabama 1975, commonly known as the
24	Omnibus Pay Act, to provide that uniform increases in
25	compensation granted to local officials would be included in
26	the initial compensation of the local officials.

Section 1. Section 11-2A-4 of the Code of Alabama 1975,

29 30 "\$11-2A-4 (a) (1) After August 1, 2016, the local officials 31 32 covered by this chapter shall be entitled to receive the same 33 uniform increases in compensation, whether the uniform increases are based on a percentage of compensation or a flat 34 35 dollar amount, that are granted equally to all county 36 employees by the county commission. The increases shall be in 37 the same amount or percentage, as the case may be, as that amount or percentage increase provided to the county's 38 39 employees. (2) Except as otherwise provided herein, officials in 40 41

Category 2 shall be eligible for the cost-of-living increases beginning on October 1, 2000. If the implementation of this chapter increases the compensation of an incumbent office holder, the increase shall be paid as provided in subdivision (5) of Section 11-2A-2.

(3) The base compensation for the purposes of implementation of this subsection shall be that compensation established on October 1, 2000, and shall remain those respective amounts until increased as provided under the provisions of this chapter of any local official elected or appointed after July 1, 2025, shall be the compensation of the immediately prior officeholder including any uniform increases received by the prior officeholder. Any official shall continue to be entitled to receive uniform increases in compensation as provided in subdivision (1).

57	notwithstanding, the Legislature, by local law, may increase
58	the compensation for local officials covered under this
59	chapter. However, if a local law increases the compensation of
60	a local official, <u>such</u> the local official shall <u>not</u> be
61	entitled to any uniform increases pursuant to the procedure in
62	subsection (a), until such time as the total compensation he
63	or she would have received under subsection (a) is equal to or
64	exceeds the increase provided by the local law except as
65	otherwise provided by local law."
