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Enrolled, An Act,

To make supplemental appropriations for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025: from Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy Fund to the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy in the amount of \$100,000; from Court Automation Fund to the Unified Judicial System in the amount of \$8,017,325; from Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund to the Unified Judicial System in the amount of \$4,588,740; from the Alabama Recycling Fund to the Department of Environmental Management in the amount of \$2,000,000; from Departmental Receipts to the Department of Commerce in the amount of \$5,000,000; from federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act - State Small Business Initiative Fund to the Department of Finance in the amount of \$50,000,000, estimated; and to amend Act 2024-355, the General Fund Appropriation Bill for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, to increase the amount appropriated to the Alabama Department of Transportation for paying the principal of and interest on bonds issued for the purposes of public highways and bridges.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$100,000 from Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy Fund to the Alabama State Board of Public Accountancy for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.

Section 2. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated



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\$8,017,325 from the Court Automation Fund to the Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and personnel costs and for other general operations of the Unified Judicial System.

Section 3. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$4,588,740 from the Advanced Technology and Data Exchange Fund to the Unified Judicial System for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the funds appropriated under this section may be spent on salaries and personnel costs and for other general operations of the Unified Judicial System.

Section 4. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$2,000,000 from the Alabama Recycling Fund to the Department of Environmental Management for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.

Section 5. In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$5,000,000 from the Departmental Receipts to the Department of Commerce for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025.

Section 6. (a) In addition to all other appropriations heretofore and hereafter made, there is hereby appropriated \$50,000,000, estimated, in federal funds from the American Rescue Plan Act - State Small Business Credit Initiative Fund to the Department of Finance for the fiscal year ending



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September 30, 2025. These funds may be delegated through memoranda of agreement to the Alabama Innovation Corporation or other entity so designated by the Department of Finance.

Section 7. Any amount of the funds appropriated in this act remaining unexpended on September 30, 2025, shall be reappropriated for the same purposes for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025.

Section 8. Section 3C of Act 2024-355, the General Appropriations Act for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2025, is hereby amended as follows:

"124. Transportation Department of...

There is hereby appropriated for payment of the principal of and the interest on all bonds heretofore or hereafter issued for public highways and bridge purposes, or either, by the State of Alabama, Alabama Federal Aid Highway Finance Authority, Alabama Highway Finance Corporation, or Alabama Industrial Access Road and Bridge Corporation, a total of ~~\$113,253,921~~ \$126,253,921 or so much thereof as may be necessary for payment of said principal and interest at their respective maturities, of the revenues pledged for such payment. There is also hereby appropriated an amount not to exceed \$25,000,000 as an annual contribution to the Alabama Transportation Infrastructure Bank, if needed, for payment of debt service. The Director of Transportation, with the consent of the Governor and the Director of Finance, shall have the authority to transfer any appropriation or any portion thereof between and among subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) of this section whenever such transfer shall be necessary to assure



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85 maximum utilization of federal matching funds which shall
86 become available. In the event that there shall not be
87 sufficient funds available for payment of all appropriations
88 hereinabove made, the following provisions shall be
89 applicable. In the event of such insufficiency in respect of
90 said revenues accruing to the Department of Transportation:
91 (1) the appropriation made for Debt Service in subdivisions
92 (a) and (b) hereof shall be paid in full, and (2) the
93 appropriations from the revenues accruing to the Department of
94 Transportation that are herein made for the purposes referred
95 to in subdivisions (a), (b) and (c) except for Debt Service,
96 hereof shall be allocated among the purposes referred to in
97 said subdivisions in such order and with such priorities as
98 the Director of the Department of Transportation shall from
99 time to time direct. The funds appropriated in subdivisions
100 (a) and (c) hereof, for the matching federal funds, shall not
101 revert at the end of the fiscal year for which such
102 appropriations are made but shall remain available for the
103 purposes for which such appropriations were made. In addition
104 to all appropriations hereinabove made, there is hereby
105 appropriated to the Department of Transportation all federal
106 funds accruing thereto to be expended only for the purpose for
107 which such Funds are made available."

108 Section 9. This act shall become effective immediately
109 upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or its
110 otherwise becoming law.
