12	Section 1. (a) Upon written request by the presiding
13	juvenile judge of the county, a county commission, by
14	resolution adopted no later than 90 days after the effective
15	date of this act, may assume the supervision and
16	administration of the county's juvenile detention facility and
17	the individuals employed to work in the facility. Upon the
18	passage of a resolution, the commission may hire a detention
19	superintendent to manage the facility and the facility's
20	employees on behalf of the commission.
21	(b) The Supreme Court of Alabama shall review and
22	revise as necessary the Rules of Juvenile Procedure to ensure
23	compliance with this section.
24	Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately.
