9	Relating to vaccines; to amend Section 22-8-4, Code of
10	Alabama 1975; to require written consent of a parent or legal
11	guardian for any minor to receive a vaccination, with
12	exception.
13	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
14	Section 1. Section 22-8-4, Code of Alabama 1975, is
15	amended to read as follows:
16	"\$22-8-4
17	<u>(a)</u> Any minor who is 14 years of age or older, or has
18	graduated from high school, or is married, or having been
19	married is divorced, or is pregnant may give effective consent
20	to any legally authorized medical, dental, health or mental
21	health services for himself or herself, and the consent of no
22	other person -shall be is necessary.
23	(b) Notwithstanding subsection (a), an unemancipated
24	minor may not give consent to the administration of a
25	vaccination for himself or herself without the written consent
26	of a parent or legal guardian. Additionally, an unemancipated
27	minor may not give consent to the administration of a
28	vaccination for himself or herself unless the minor is: (i)



- 29 not dependent on a parent or legal guardian for support; or
- 30 (ii) living apart from his or her parents or another
- 31 individual acting in loco parentis."
- 32 Section 2. This act shall become effective October 1,
- 33 2025.
