A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to St. Clair County; to amend Section 1 of Act 2023-120, 2023 Regular Session; to further provide for the compensation of the revenue commissioner; and to repeal Section 4 of Act 2020-182, 2020 Regular Session, relating to the compensation of the revenue commissioner.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 1 of Act 2023-120, 2023 Regular Session, is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. (a) Effective beginning ~~on the first day of the month following the effective date of this act~~June 1, 2023, the Revenue Commissioner of St. Clair County shall receive an additional expense ~~account~~allowance in an amount equal to the difference in the salary of the Revenue Commissioner of St. Clair County on ~~the effective date of this act~~May 5, 2023, and the salary of the Judge of Probate of St. Clair County payable in equal monthly installments from the general fund of the county. This expense allowance shall be in lieu of any other expense allowance authorized for the Revenue Commissioner of St. Clair County ~~is receiving~~prior to June 1, 2023.

29           (b) Effective beginning June 1, 2025, in addition to  
30 the expense allowance provided in subsection (a), the Revenue  
31 Commissioner shall receive an expense allowance of three  
32 hundred seventy five dollars (\$375) per month from the general  
33 fund of the county.

34           ~~(b)(c) Effective beginning the next term of office~~  
35 ~~after the effective date of this act~~October 1, 2027, the  
36 Revenue Commissioner of St. Clair County shall receive an  
37 annual salary equal to the salary of the Judge of Probate of  
38 St. Clair County and ~~subsection~~ subsections (a) and (b) shall  
39 be void."

40           Section 2. Section 4 of Act 2020-182, 2020 Regular  
41 Session, related to the compensation of the Revenue  
42 Commissioner of St. Clair County, is repealed.

43           Section 3. This act shall become effective on June 1,  
44 2025.
