AN ACT

Relating to Medicaid, to require coverage of rapid whole genome sequencing for certain individuals in the Medicaid program.

22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

> Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, "rapid whole genome sequencing" is defined as an investigation of the entire human genome, including coding and non-coding regions and mitochondrial deoxyribonucleic acid, which yields a preliminary positive result of a disease-causing genetic change within five days, and a final result of the same within

- 41 trauma.
- 42 (3) Is a hospital inpatient in an intensive care unit,
- 43 including a neonatal intensive care unit, or a high acuity
- 44 pediatric unit.
- 45 Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
- 46 1, 2025.
