9	Relating to education; to amend Section 16-40A-5, Code
10	of Alabama 1975; to prohibit classroom instruction in public
11	school prekindergarten through the twelfth grade related to
12	gender identity or sexual orientation; to prohibit education
13	employees from displaying certain flags and insignia in public
14	preK-12 schools; and to prohibit education employees from
15	referring to a student by pronouns inconsistent with the
16	student's biological sex.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Section 16-40A-5, Code of Alabama 1975, is
19	amended to read as follows:
20	"\$16-40A-5
21	(a) An individual or group of individuals providing
22	classroom instruction to students in kindergarten
23	<u>prekindergarten</u> through the <u>fifth</u> twelfth grade at a public
24	<u>K-12</u> preK-12 school shall not engage in classroom discussion
25	or provide classroom instruction regarding sexual orientation
26	or gender identity in a manner that is not age appropriate or
27	developmentally appropriate for students in accordance with
28	state standards.

29	(b) No teacher, or other public preK-12 employee, may
30	display a flag or other insignia relating to or representing
31	sexual orientation or gender identity in a classroom of a
32	public preK-12 school.
33	(b)(c) The State Board of Education shall adopt rules
34	for the implementation and enforcement of this section."
35	Section 2. This act shall become effective on July 1,
36	2025.
