9	Relating to sex offenders; to amend Sections 15-20A-13						
10	and 15-20A-31, Code of Alabama 1975, to prohibit sex offenders						
11	from being employed or volunteering as a first responder.						
12	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:						
13	Section 1. Sections 15-20A-13 and 15-20A-31, Code of						
14	Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:						
15	"\$15-20A-13						
16	(a) No adult sex offender shall accept or maintain						
17	employment or a volunteer position at any school, childcare						
18	facility, mobile vending business that provides services						
19	primarily to children, or any other business or organization						
20	that provides services primarily to children, or any amusement						
21	or water park.						
22	(b) No adult sex offender shall accept or maintain						
23	employment or a volunteer position within 2,000 feet of the						
24	property on which a school or childcare facility is located						
25	unless otherwise exempted pursuant to Sections 15-20A-24 and						
26	15-20A-25.						
27	(c) No adult sex offender, after having been convicted						

28 of a sex offense involving a child, shall accept or maintain



employment or a volunteer position within 500 feet of a playground, park, athletic field or facility, or any other business or facility having a principal purpose of caring for, educating, or entertaining minors.

33 (d) Changes to property within 2,000 feet of an adult 34 sex offender's place of employment which occur after an adult 35 sex offender accepts employment shall not form the basis for 36 finding that an adult sex offender is in violation of this 37 section.

(e) It shall be unlawful for the owner or operator of
any childcare facility or any other organization that provides
services primarily to children to knowingly provide employment
or a volunteer position to an adult sex offender.

42 (f) For <u>the purposes</u> of this section, the 2,000-foot 43 measurement shall be taken in a straight line from nearest 44 property line to nearest property line.

45 (g) (1) No adult sex offender shall accept or maintain
 46 employment or a volunteer position as a first responder.

47 (2) For the purposes of this section, a "first
48 responder" means a paramedic, firefighter, rescue squad
49 member, emergency medical technician, or other individual who,

50 in the course of his or her professional duties, responds to

51 fire, medical, hazardous material, or other similar

52 emergencies, whether compensated or not.

53 (g) (h) Any person who knowingly violates this section 54 shall be guilty of a Class C felony."

71	member, emergency medical technician, or other individual who,							
72	in the course of his or her professional duties, responds to							
73	fire, medical, hazardous material, or other similar							
74	emergencies, whether compensated or not.							
75	(c)(d) Any person who knowingly violates this section							
76	shall be guilty of a Class C felony."							
77	Section 2. This act shall become effective on October							
78	1, 2025.
