10	12-12-56, Code of Alabama 1975; to require law enforcement to
11	make a reasonable effort to notify the minor's emergency
12	contact when citing a minor for traffic infractions; and to
13	provide exceptions.
14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
15	Section 1. This act shall be known and may be cited as
16	"TJ's Law."
17	Section 2. Section 12-12-56, Code of Alabama 1975, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	"\$12-12-56
20	(a) No law enforcement officer or other officer or
21	public employee shall dispose of a uniform traffic ticket and
22	<code>complaint</code> or any portion thereof $\underline{\prime}$ or the record of issuance
23	thereof $_{\underline{\prime}}$ in a manner other than as required under rules $_{\overline{\mathrm{or}}}$
24	regulations promulgated adopted pursuant to this
25	subsectionarticle.
26	(b) Any person who solicits or aids in the disposition
27	or attempted disposition of a uniform traffic ticket and
28	complaint, or any portion thereof, in any unauthorized manner

29	is subject to the criminal contempt power of the district or
30	municipal court.
31	(c) If a minor under 19 years of age is cited for any
32	traffic infraction, the citing agency shall make a reasonable
33	effort to notify the driver's emergency contact, if available.
34	For the purposes of this subsection, a single attempted
35	telephone call, text message, or letter sent via United States
36	mail to the driver's emergency contact shall constitute a
37	reasonable effort to notify."
38	Section 3. This act shall become effective on October
39	1, 2025.
