SYNOPSIS:

This bill would require each county and municipal law enforcement agency to report annually the number of sworn law enforcement officers employed by the agency to the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency and the Attorney General.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to county and municipal law enforcement agencies; to require each county and municipal law enforcement agency to report the number of sworn law enforcement officers employed by the agency to the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency and the Attorney General.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Not later than February 1, annually, each county and municipal law enforcement agency shall report, on a form prescribed by the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency, the number of sworn law enforcement officers certified by the Alabama Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission who are employed by the agency.
