The estimated average hourly wage. 37 f. The estimated value of the jobs credit. g. The estimated value of the investment credit. 38 39 h. The projected 10-year and 20-year return on incentives. 40 i. The value of any cash incentive that was committed. 41 42 j. The value of any repayment of tax incentives awarded 43 to a company due to failure to comply with the terms of the project agreement by the incentivized company. 44 45 (2) Aggregated performance data on all projects 46 incentivized under this article."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on October
