A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to crimes and offenses; to provide that a defendant who is an illegal alien who is convicted of a criminal offense must receive an enhanced sentence in certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purpose of this section "illegal alien" means an individual not entitled to lawfully reside or work in the United States.

(b) In all cases when it is shown that a criminal defendant, who is an illegal alien, has been convicted of a felony where the victim is a minor, he or she must be punished as follows:

(1) On a conviction of a Class D felony, for a Class C felony.

(2) On a conviction of a Class C felony, for a Class B felony.

(3) On a conviction of a Class B felony, for a Class A felony.

(4) On a conviction of a Class A felony, by

29 imprisonment for life or for any term of not more than 99
30 years, but not less than 15 years.

31 (c) In all cases when it is shown that a criminal
