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13	Relating to local boards of education; to provide for
14	semi-monthly salary payments of local board of education
15	employees; and to provide for local boards of education to opt
16	out of semi-monthly salary payments.
17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. (a) Beginning August 1, 2026, each local
19	board of education shall pay the employees of the board
20	semi-monthly one payday in arrears. Except as otherwise
21	provided in this section, salary payments based on the
22	semi-monthly plan shall be made on the first and sixteenth day
23	of each month.
24	(b) If the first or sixteenth day of any month, other
25	than the first day of October, falls on a Saturday, a Sunday,
26	or a holiday, then the salary payment shall be made on the
27	last workday immediately prior to the Saturday, the Sunday, or

the holiday. If the first day of October falls on a Saturday,

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- a Sunday, or a holiday, then the salary payment shall be made on the next succeeding workday.
- 31 (c) A local board of education may opt out of the 32 provisions of this section by written board resolution. The 33 board must file this resolution with the State Superintendent 34 of Education within 60 days of passage of the resolution.
- 35 (d) The state Comptroller, the State Superintendent of 36 Education, and the State Board of Education shall adopt 37 policies to implement the provisions of this section.
- 38 (e) It is the intent of the Legislature that the
 39 implementation of a semi-monthly pay plan shall not reduce any
 40 employee's annual rate of compensation.
- Section 2. This act shall become effective on July 1, 2025.
